Uniform Details

For blazers and ties, the Academy has three colour stripe variants of uniform depending on the college the student is assigned to:

- Apollo green
- Jupiter red
- Minerva blue

Students should bring a coat during modules one to four. Students are also welcome to bring a plain umbrella if rain is forecast during the school day.

All uniforms should clearly indicate the student's name.

Not permitted:

- Trainers students should wear the correct shoes.
- Hoodies, tracksuit tops, denim jackets and leather coats students should wear the correct blazer, jumper and coat.
- Tracksuit bottoms or shorts being worn under trousers.
- Jewellery including bracelets, rings, earrings or facial jewellery. Students are permitted to wear one pair of stud earrings only – one earring in each earlobe.
- Smart watches other watches may be worn and handed to a teacher during certain activities such as PE.
- Nail varnish or fake nails of any kind, including tips.
- Make-up fake tan, fake eyelashes, lipstick, mascara and excessive make-up.
- Hair extreme hair colours are not permitted and hair must be one tone and a natural colour. Unusual hairstyles, including tram lines, are not permitted.

Note:

- The Academy has the final decision on uniform.
- Any item that is not permitted, such as jewellery or smart watches, will be confiscated and returned to the student (at the end of the day or on another day) or parent/carer when they attend the Academy. Students who refuse to have an item confiscated will be sanctioned.
- Any uniform infringement that cannot or will not be corrected will result in the student being isolated within their college area or the reflection room until it is corrected.
- In accordance with section 94(2) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, neither staff nor the Academy can be held liable for any loss or damage of a confiscated item.
